PH 210 **Christian Ethics** (3)

Students will study current moral issues in the light of Scripture, applying biblical principles to the problems that confront society today, including abortion, infanticide, biomedical issues, capital punishment, war, civil disobedience, homosexuality, divorce and ecological issues. This course also deals with a refutation of moral relativism.

DEFERRED PAYMENT PLAN

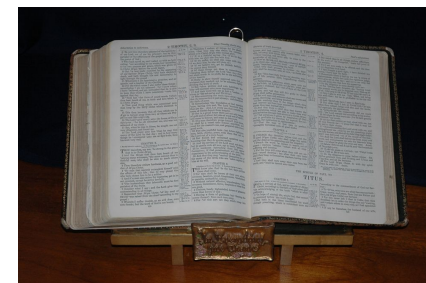
